ORDINANCE NO. 2025-022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION, HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REAUTHORIZING THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF PERCENT (0.50%); AND PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: FINDINGS OF FACT; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROPER NOTICE & MEETING.

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2025, the City Council adopted Ordinance 2025-007 calling a special election and establishing the procedure for the special election to reauthorize the local sales and use tax for maintenance and repair of municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, on said election, the following proposition was submitted to the qualified voters of the City:

PROPOSITION

The reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, at the rate of one-half (1/2) of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. The tax expires on the eighth anniversary of the date of this election unless the imposition of the tax is reauthorized.

WHEREAS, this election was duly and legally held on November 4, 2025, in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the election have been certified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall convene not later than the eleventh (11th) day after the election date for the purpose of canvassing the election results; and

WHEREAS, section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results and provides that two (2) members of the canvassing authority constitute a quorum for purposes of canvassing the election; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council, and the Council finds, that the election was in all aspects lawfully held; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council, and the Council finds, that the tabulation of the results of

the election are correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, THAT:

1. ELECTION

- A.** The Special Election of the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, was held on November 4, 2025, was duly called, that notice of said election was given, that said election was held in accordance with the law.
- B.** The tabulation of votes cast in the Special Election held on November 4, 2025, for the purpose of reauthorizing the local sales and use tax for maintenance and repair of municipal streets, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance is adopted as the official tabulation of the votes cast at the election, and the tabulation will be filed and recorded in the official records of the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, as the official canvass of the election.

2. CANVASSING THE RETURNS

The official canvass of the returns of the election reflects the following:

3. ELECTION RESULTS

The returns as set forth herein are ordered and declared to be official; that Proposition A reauthorizing a local sales and use tax in the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, at the rate of one-half percent (0.50%) for maintenance and repair of municipal streets, is hereby recognized and declared to have passed.

The above-named proposition was hereby duly approved by voters at said election and shall be reported to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

4. AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE

The Mayor of the City of West Lake Hills is authorized to execute, and the City Secretary is authorized to attest this Ordinance on behalf of the City Council. The Mayor is further authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

5. REPEALER

All ordinances, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

6. SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections, or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

8. PROPER NOTICE & MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.
